Parking Rules & Regulations

1. Parking permits must be displayed hanging from the rearview mirror with the number clearly visible or affixed to the lower right hand corner of the windshield on the passenger side.
2. All parking lots and areas are designated by signs or markings specifying the type of permit required (such as Faculty/Staff, Resident, Commuter & Overflow). Each permit has a letter which indicates the required lot(s) to park in.  
**R- Resident C- Commuter O-Overflow**
3. Parking permits are valid only in “parking spaces” which refers to the specifically marked parking area designated by white painted lines in paved surface lots and decks, and white-striped rubber bumper blocks in gravel surface lots. The color yellow indicates that parking is prohibited. The color blue with appropriate approved signage indicates accessibility parking for disabled individuals.
4. Valid permits allow parking in designated lots with the exception of metered spaces (unless sufficient funds have been deposited). Parking is prohibited in areas with restrictive signs, loading zones, fire lanes, yellow bumper blocks and markings, and in areas that do not have white parking space markings. Parking permits are not valid in handicap spaces (unless accompanied by a state or University issued handicap placard).
5. In all cases in which a motor vehicle is parked, the position shall be such that the whole of the vehicle is located within the white line boundaries of the parking space.
6. If there are three (3) or more unpaid parking violations on a license plate, Parking Services may impound the vehicle with an immobilization device. If a vehicle contains a false, altered, forged, lost or stolen permit, the University of Akron Police and the Office of Parking Services may have the vehicle towed from university owned or operated property.

**Attention: University of Akron Parking Permit Holders**

The Office of Parking Services, Cashier’s Office and Residence Life and Housing are the only authorized departments to sell or distribute University parking permits. Possessing or displaying a stolen, forged, or altered permit, or manufacturing a University permit is a criminal offense and subject to criminal prosecution. The University of Akron Police Department and Parking Services will enforce this policy.

**Commercial Parking Permit Restrictions**  
**Effective 1/11/2010**

- Permits cost to Vendors/Contractors is \$130.00,(\$120.00 restricted)
- Only authorized Contractor Management / Project Managers for the job site are permitted to park close to construction sites with unrestricted permits
- Restricted Commercial Visitor parking permits for Contractor/Laborer employees are valid only in the following lots: lot 59 (282 Torrey St.), 54 (The Chapel), lot 17 (Vine St.) and lot 7 (475 Orchard St.) Campus maps displaying these lot locations are available at the Parking Services website at: [www.uakron.edu/parking](http://www.uakron.edu/parking) .The Parking Services phone number is (330) 972 – 7213.
- Parking in non – designated lots will result in a parking citation.
- The payment of any fines is NOT a billable cost back to the University.

Contractors that are to be on campus for short periods of time may purchase a temporary permit at the Parking Services office at a cost of \$6.00 per day. Parking Services will assist in determining the most economical permit to purchase a semester permit versus a temporary permit.
