Financial Documentation

According to U.S. Government regulations, your financial documentation must prove that you have enough readily available funds to meet all expenses for the first year of program, and adequate funds will be available for each subsequent year of study.

- 1 Affidavit(s) of Support.** All funding sources (personal, family, institutional) must complete the appropriate *Affidavit of Support* on back of this form or provide their letter of sponsorship. The total funds indicated on the affidavit(s) must be enough to cover **all your expenses for entire period of your study** (i.e. 4 years for a Bachelor's/ Doctoral Programs, 2 years for a Master's Program and etc.)
- 2 Bank Statement(s).** Each personal sponsor (family, friends) must provide a bank statement showing the type of currency used on account and the amount readily available for the first year of program.

- If your sponsor is an U.S. Citizen or a Permanent Resident, s/he should complete the Form I-134 "Affidavit of Support." You can obtain this form in the Office of International Programs (phone 330-972-6349, FAX 330-972-8604).
- If you are a graduate student in receipt of an assistantship or a tuition waiver, your documents must reflect the amount not covered by the award. If you have asked to be considered for an assistantship but not received the award yet, your funds must meet the requirements above. Providing this information will not affect your chances for The University's financial support.
- All documentation must meet the following requirements: Be dated no more than one year prior to the starting date of your program; Be originals, no photocopies; Be written in English, translation must be signed and sealed by the appropriate bank or government official; Include both your name and the sponsor's name.

Estimated Expenses for the School Year
