Bassist Tracy Rowell is an active performer and teacher in the Cleveland area. As a soloist, she has appeared with Apollo's Fire and with the Canton Symphony, where she has served as principal bassist. As a chamber musician, she has performed with the Carmel Bach Festival, the Cleveland Chamber Collective, and other ensembles. Currently on the faculty of the University of Akron and the Cleveland Institute of Music Preparatory Division, Ms. Rowell has appeared as a clinician and recitalist at bass workshops. Prior to moving to Cleveland, she was the Assistant Principal Bassist of the National Arts Centre Orchestra in Ottawa, one of Canada's premiere orchestras. She has also performed with the Boston Symphony Orchestra, Boston Pops Esplanade Orchestra, North Carolina Symphony, and Columbus Symphony. She received fellowships from the Aspen Music Festival and Tanglewood Music Center, and she participated in the George Solti Orchestral Project. Ms. Rowell graduated from Rice University, where she studied with Paul Ellison, and she received her Masters degree from Boston University, as a student of Edwin Barker. Currently Tracy leads a busy life in Cleveland Heights with her husband, Henry Peyrebrune, and their five young children.
