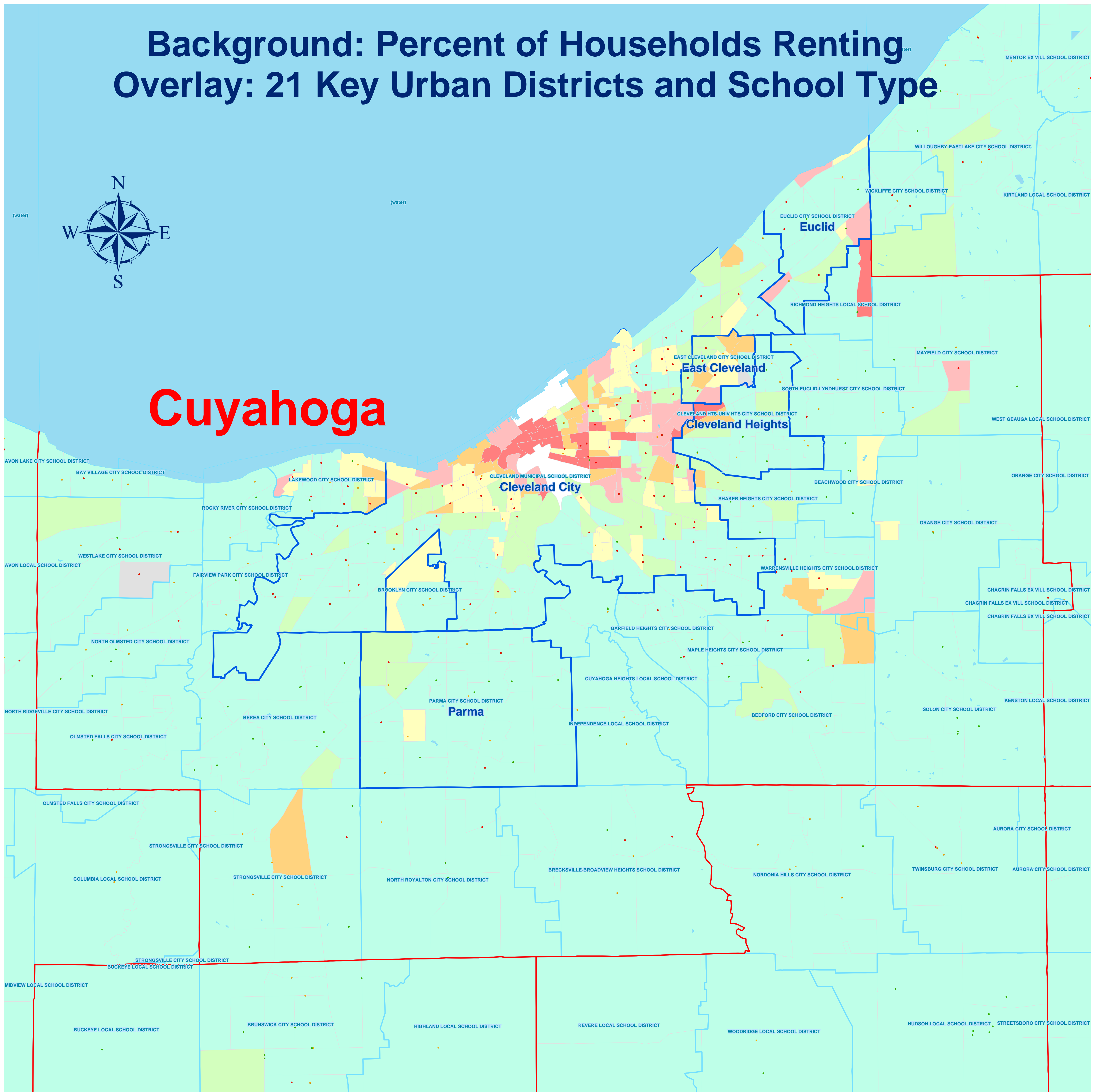


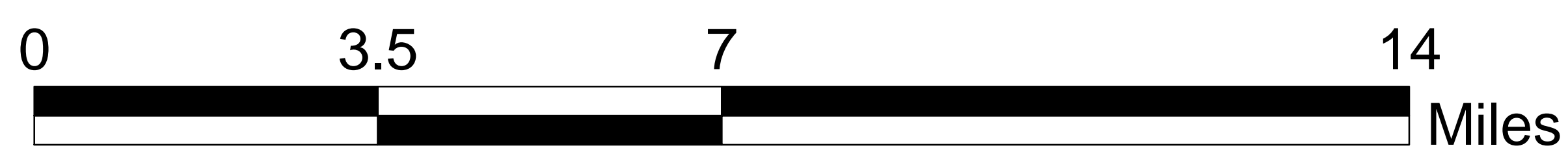
# Title I Policy Penetration into Urban Districts
