



# Percent of respondents who would rate the quality of job opportunities in Northeast Ohio as Excellent or Good






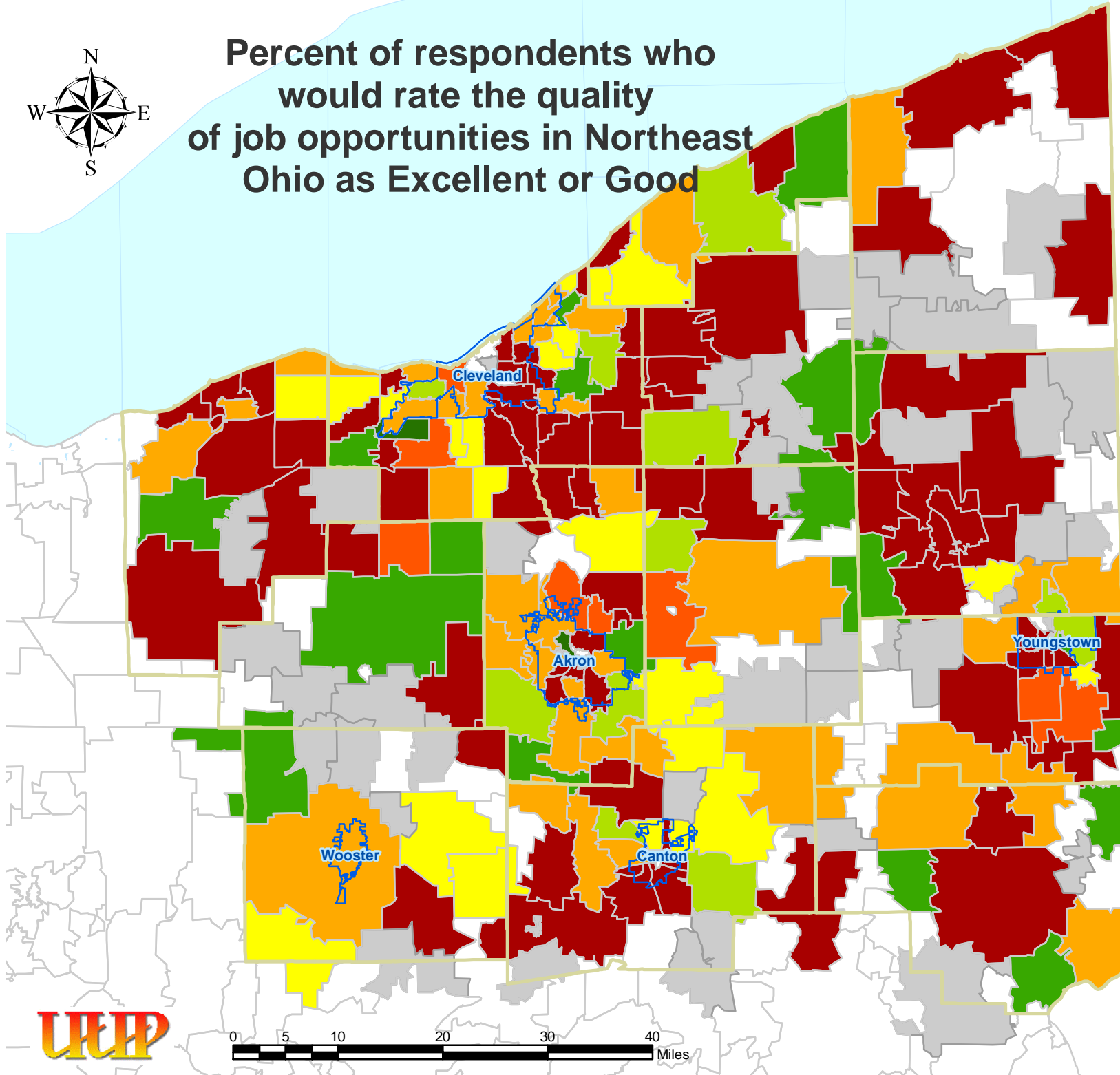
